Course Description

Students will create a simple design that can be transferred onto a clear piece of glass. Colored glass pieces will be glued in the design or pattern. The process should take the morning session from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. On the following day, students will learn to grout and clean their project, ready to frame 1:00 pm-4:00 pm

Materials List:

Protective eyewear (cutting and/or breaking small glass pieces may be required)

An 8x10 picture frame with glass intact (inexpensive is OK- especially for beginners)

Glue- GORILLA Clear-glue (small button 1.75 oz)

Material Fees: \$2.00 per student

Materials fees will be charged for materials used in the studio and/or provided by instructors for use in the studio by the entire class. In order to keep these fees as low as possible , fees are assessed on an individual class basis and may vary from class to class depending on the amount of materials used and the number of students in the class. Materials fees are paid at the beginning of the class.
