Basic Blacksmithing: 1 Day Class Robin Lynch June 30th 9am-4pm

Course Description

Learn basic blacksmithing techniques used to turn raw metal into functional items! Learn drawing out, rounding, bending, twisting, scrolling, flattening and more, with an emphasis on hammer control.

Each student will review shop safety and then make several "J" hooks, "S" hooks, a dinner triangle, and more if time allows.

Materials List:

Each student is required to bring and wear leather work gloves and safety glasses. Please wear properly fitting work clothes and shoes. There is a \$20 materials fee required from each student at the beginning of the course, payable to the instructor. There will be a one hour lunch break at noon; students may bring their own food or may travel a short distance to one of several local food establishments.

Material Fees: \$20.00

Materials fees will be charged for materials used in the studio and/or provided by instructors for use in the studio by the entire class. In order to keep these fees as low as possible, fees are assessed on an individual class basis and may vary from class to class depending on the amount of materials used and the number of students in the class. Materials fees are paid at the beginning of the class.
