## **Basic Blacksmithing: 2 Day Class**

### **Course Description**

Learn basic blacksmithing techniques used to transform hot steel into items that are both useful and aesthetically pleasing! Techniques Include drawing out, rounding, scrolling, bending, twisting, hot cutting, hot punching, chamfering, fullering, riveting, and more!

Each student will review shop safety and then learn these techniques, as well as practice hammer control, by creating several "j" hooks, "s" hooks, a dinner triangle, a hook rack, a steak turner, and more if time allows.

### **Materials List:**

Each student is required to bring and wear leather work gloves and safety glasses. Please wear properly fitting work clothes and shoes.

### **Material Fees: \$20.00**
